## HX210 VHF Radio Use Guide

These radios are for use on Hedgecourt Lake only. Following this guide does not qualify the user to use other Marine radios for which a licence is required.

Do not press the red 16/S button, it is an emergency feature that will not elicit a response on the lake. If inadvertently pressed the channel will switch to 16, press again to switch back to M2.

Radios are locked to channel M2, unless 16/S is pressed - don't do that.

Radios are set to low power (LO)

1. Turn the radio on by holding the red button on the right-hand side front for a second.
2. Check the battery level.
3. Attach the radio with the clip **and** lanyard.
4. Check that you can communicate with other users before going afloat - Press to talk (PTT button top lefthand side) / Release to listen.
5. After use, turn the radio off and return it to the charging station, check that the mains plug is plugged into the timer and that the power is on (wall switch and fused outlet box above the light switch).

### Calling procedure example:

"Support Boat, Support Boat, Support Boat this is Race Control, Race Control. **Over**"

"Race Control, Race Control this is Support Boat. **Over**"

"Support Boat this is Race Control, please move mark .... **Over**"

"Race Control this is Support Boat, all done. **Out**"

"Support Boat this is Race Control. **Out**"

Any further communication should start with the call sign repeated three times.
